

Deadline Approaching: Late fee Amnesty for Certain Outside Business Activities

Another frigid month has passed, bringing us closer to spring. This would normally be a good thing. But the onset of March brings us perilously closer to an important deadline.

Our [January bulletin](#) discussed the Ontario Securities Commission's one-time late fee amnesty for outside business activities (OBAs) that were not previously reported on time. The deadline to submit your application is **March 27, 2015**, and work will need to be done to prepare the application. Please call us right away if you are thinking of addressing undisclosed OBAs.
